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1. Introduction

The aim of the present document (Deliverable C.2.3) is to present the main initiatives, achievements and results of CIRCE project.

ABOUT CIRCE

CIRCE "Common Initiatives to pRomote CinEma across Italy-Albania-Montenegro" is funded by the Interreg IPA CBC Italy-Albania-Montenegro Programme under Priority Axis 2. The project aims to re-launch the production system of Albania, Montenegro, Puglia and Molise, investing in cultural and creative industries as key strategic resources to support the economic growth of the involved areas.

Project partners are the Apulia Film Commission Foundation (AFC), lead partner, the Albanian National Centre of Cinematography (ANCC), the Film Centre of Montenegro (FCM) and the Molise Region (MR). Associated partners are: the Ministry of Culture of Montenegro, the Ministry of Culture Republic of Albania and the Ministry of Culture of Italy.

OBJECTIVE AND ACTIVITIES

The overall objective is improving the conditions for cultural and creative industries of the audio-visual sector in order to give value to the cultural heritage through crossborder initiatives, establishing an important connection among participating regions and key actors of new creative productions.

CIRCE implemented a comprehensive program of cross-border initiatives in the audiovisual sector setting up networks at different levels that will involve the main stakeholders. Among the activities:

- · The joint production of a nine-episodes web series on a cross-border platform;
- · The creation of a Network of Film Festivals in the cross-border area;
- · Investments to promote distribution in Albania and Montenegro;
- The transfer of good successful practices (tax credit);
- · Updating activities for operators of the audio-visual sector.

2. CIRCE Web Series

Apulia Film Commission Foundation (AFC) produced an anthological web series of nine episodes on the subject of "journey" in order to promote the natural, cultural, artistic and architectural heritage of the involved territories.

Particularly, the aim of the web series is to strengthen the visibility and recognisability of Albania, Montenegro, Molise region and Puglia region through audiovisual tools, assigning this task to **young under-35 directors** coming from the involved territories and making them protagonists of their own lands' cultural development.

The directors and executive productions were identified through a **public call**, launched and spread with the support of project partners, and the winners were selected by a first-class **international evaluation commission**.

Before the contracting phase, a **brainstorming meeting** was held on 31.07.2019 at the premises of Apulia Film Commission to give directors and executive producers an overview of the steps to take and arrange one-to-one meetings with the Showrunner, and the Delegate Producers.

3. Network of Film Festivals

Thanks to CIRCE project, on 9 August 2019, several directors of Film Festivals from Albania, Montenegro, Puglia and Molise gathered and <u>met</u> in Casacalenda (Molise) on the occasion of the 17th edition of MoliseCinema Film Festival, and signed a Memorandum of Understanding for the creation of a Network of Film Festivals of Albania, Montenegro, Molise and Puglia.



The aim of the Network is to promote cooperation in the audiovisual sector in the cross- border area and to improve the artistic quality of the respective festivals, thus enhancing the cultural offer in the area. The Network is intended as a space for the exchange of experience and best practices, as well as an instrument for coordinating activities and promoting the Network as a whole.

The 2nd Meeting of the Network of Film Festivals, was held on 5th November 2020 in online form. The meeting was hosted by the Festival del Cinema Europeo 2020 (from 31 October to 07 November 2020) and was the occasion to outline together the Network's Statute, made up of 8 articles regulating its functioning and structure.

The Statute was adopted and signed by the following 10 festivals, but any Film Festivals of Albania, Montenegro, Molise and Puglia can join at any time.





















4. Support to Film Festivals

Thanks to CIRCE, project partners had the opportunity to support several Film Festivals taking place in their territories. In occasion of these festivals, several cross-border initiatives, panels, short movies and films from the CIRCE project area were organized and hosted. The aim was to enhance the mutual knowledge and promote the circulation of Italian, Albanian and Montenegrin movies. The involved festivals are detailed below.

5. Cineport Hubs in Albania

Thanks to CIRCE project, the Albanian National Centre of Cinematography has equipped the **cinema halls** of the cities of Vlora and Gjirokastra - located in the South and South east of Albania respectively and closed for more than 20 years - with new digital technologies, making them two Cineport Hubs, working as new places of growth and cultural aggregation.

6. Art Movie Circuit in ME

Thanks to CIRCE project, the Film Centre of Montenegro has purchased a **Mobile Cinema Package** in order to offer an itinerant art movie circuit all around Montenegro, promoting a quality cinema schedule and diversifying and expanding the quality of cultural offerings through an innovative and targeted management of cinema.

This investment aims to promote the distribution and diffusion of cinematographic works through free projections and was already tested as support for the preparation of several Film Festivals of Montenegro during CIRCE project lifetime.

The package involves a high-level quality projector, accompanied with mobile screen and sound system, which can be easily set up in many outdoor and indoor places, allowing audience to get the exquisite screening events, and also a van to move all around the country.



7. Molise Cinelab

Molise Region arranged an online cross-border **Cinelab** focused on new technologies and addressed to operators and enterprises working in the audiovisual industry matching the current requests of the market and promoting cooperation in the project area.

The initiative lasted 5 days from 18 to 25 March 2021 and took place online, involving about 30 participants from Albania, Montenegro, Molise and Puglia. The rich program gave the opportunity to participants to get updated on the latest technologies developed in the field of audiovisual that are requested and cherished in the international market, allowing them to have new tools to develop their creativity.








8. AFC Training Week

Apulia Film Commission organized a training week on tax credit, film commission functioning and legislation for favourable movie policy for Albanian and Montenegro staff and stakeholders. The training week took place from 24 to 30 March 2021 and consisted in 5 online meetings with experts in the Italian film industry, with the aim to develop and promote the local cinema expertise in the international panorama, transfer some best practices concerning policies and projects already implemented that can foster and develop conditions for the growth of cultural and creative industries.


About 25 participants took part to the meetings belonging to partners' stakeholders but also to all people interested in this topic.





9. Tax Credit Paper

Apulia Film Commission, with the support of partners and associates drafted a Paper on Tax Credit, explaining the state of play and the legislation in force in Italy, Montenegro and Albania in this sector, in order to propose solutions and to draw a road map to conform with the tax practice implemented in Italy favourable to creative industry.



10. Memorandum of Understanding

CIRCE project partners and associates signed a Memorandum of Understanding (Mou) on a Joint Common Policy Enhancing Audiovisual Sector.

The aim of the MoU is to foster a cross-border and unitary vision in order to support the development and enhancement of the audiovisual sector in the frame of future funding opportunities at European Level.

The partners intend to cooperate using the technical and administrative capacities as well as good practices developed in the frame of the CIRCE project, fostering the joint development and implementation of initiatives and projects related to the audiovisual sector or any other sector of common interest.



11. Production & Location Guides

Albanian National Centre of Cinematography, Film Centre of Montenegro and Molise Region, thanks to a transfer of good practices from Apulia Film Commission, have implemented a database each reporting all audiovisual operators working in their respective country/region as well as the best locations for shooting.
